The **ITB 501** is a special purpose vessel with a capacity of 2000 tons.

The **ITB 501** is equipped with a very large high capacity bow ramp and a wood sheathed deck for the carriage of heavy equipment and deck cargos. The **ITB 501** has special dropping towers that are used in the raising and lowering of the bow ramp. This feature allows for the loading of extra wide equipment and logs.

ITB 501 can be used for a variety of tasks such as the carriage of aggregates to difficult locations, or heavy machinery needing a large ramp for offloading.
